- Acceptance notices will be sent electronically to corresponding authors by June 30, 2009.
- Oral presenters are encouraged to submit a paper for the conference proceedings. Proceedings papers are due **December 18, 2009**. Guidelines for proceedings papers will be provided.
- Oral presentations will be 20 minutes, with a 5 minute question / answer session following each talk.
- Poster presentations will be displayed throughout the conference. An award will be given for the best poster presentation.
